- B. Acts 2:37-42; "...gladly received..." v.46 "eat with gladness.."
- C. Psalms 122:1 "I was glad....."
- D. Acts 17:11 "...more noble..... searched scriptures...."
- E. Luke 14:28, 31 "counteth cost.."
- F. Isaiah 1:18 "Come now and let us reason together..."
